Most children do enjoy shopping for supplies in anticipation of a new school year, and if your child would like to donate any of the following materials to share, it would be greatly appreciated.

Dear Parents,

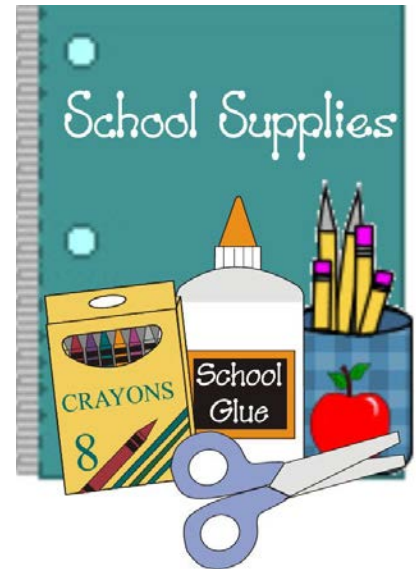
Can you believe your child is already going on to 5th grade? We would like to welcome you and your child to 5th grade here at Midland Elementary. Our grade level has come up with a list of recommended supplies for the 2016-2017 school year. As you are shopping for school supplies, please consult this list. If you would like to make a donation of any of the suggested items, we would greatly appreciate it! There is no need to label any of the supplies; we will handle this in class. In fifth grade we work hard to help the children develop their organizational skills. As such, any additional supplies (i.e. personal pencil sharpeners, art supplies, fancy pens, and any other non-listed school supplies) will be returned home.

Individual Needs:

- 1 1/2 inch **HEAVY DUTY** binder (no binders larger than 1 ½ inches or that have accordion dividers)
- 2 sets **HEAVY DUTY** notebook dividers (plastic preferred)
- 1 pack colored pencils (8 or 16 pack only)
- 1 pair of student scissors (small sized)
- 2 high quality colored (not black or blue) pen for corrections
- 2 colored highlighters
- 1 set Crayola Watercolors
- Expo dry erase markers (4 per student)
- ruler (standard and metric units)
- small pack of crayons (approximately 24)
- earbuds for technology use
