ADVANCED PLACEMENT AGREEMENT

Students at Del Norte High School who plan to attend a four-year college or university following graduation from high school, are highly encouraged to complete one or more Advanced Placement (AP) courses during their high school career. These courses are dynamic, rigorous, college-level classes that are designed to help students prepare for a successful college or university experience.

The Course Request Process measures student interest and ultimately determines whether or not a course will be offered the following year. In 2021-22 we hope to offer the following 23 Advanced Placement yearlong courses at Del Norte HS: AP Human Geography, AP European History, AP US History, AP US Government & Politics, AP English Language, AP English Literature, AP Biology, AP Chemistry, AP Physics C: Mechanics, AP Physics E&M, AP Environmental Science, AP Statistics, AP Calculus AB, AP Calculus BC, AP Computer Science Principles, AP Computer Science A, AP Studio Art Drawing, AP Studio Art 2D, AP Studio Art 3D, AP Music Theory, AP Psychology, AP Chinese Language, and AP Spanish Language. We are in the process of securing qualified teachers and appropriate instructional materials for these classes.

Staffing decisions are based upon student requests, and the materials required for these courses are costly. **Once a student requests enrollment in an Advanced Placement class, we are unable to drop them**. They must see through their commitment to the program.

Advanced Placement classes require students to approach their work very seriously. The effort required by students is greater than that required for comparable non-AP classes. Students are encouraged to carefully consider which classes are best suited to individual career interests. It is also recommended that students consider their ability level, prior academic record, extracurricular activities, and home or work responsibilities prior to deciding the number of AP classes appropriate for them.

Thank you for accepting the AP challenge. We believe that you will be a more successful college or university student because of these experiences.
