UC and CSU schools do not take letters of recommendation.</p> <p>*Minimum notice is 3 working weeks for Transcript Requests (online) and Letters of Recommendation from counselor or teacher.</p> <p>*(School is closed Nov. 19-25, So this does not count as part of the 3 working weeks notice).</p> <p>*Make sure that you have sent SAT Reasoning & Subject/ ACT results from testing agencies.</p> <p>Check PHS website monthly for updated scholarship list. Consider attending scholarship workshops.</p>	<p>>Dec.1 - SAT Reasoning & Subject Tests</p> <p>*Minimum notice for Transcript Requests (online) and Letters of Recommendation from counselor or teacher is 3 working weeks.</p> <p>(School is closed Dec. 24 - Jan.4, so this does not count as part of the 3 working weeks notice).</p> <p>*Finish applications for private & out of state schools.</p> <p>*Submit mid-year reports if using Common Application @commonapp.com</p> <p>Check PHS website monthly for updated scholarship list. Consider attending scholarship workshops.</p>	<p>>Submit after Tri.1 (midyear) transcript to colleges that request it.</p> <p>*Report any changes to your 2nd and 3rd trimester schedule to all colleges and universities.</p> <p>*Notify colleges immediately if you received any D's or F's for first, second trimester grades.</p> <p>*Check PHS website monthly for updated scholarship list.</p>
