Applying to Palomar

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Admissions

- EAP – Early Acceptance Program (for new students coming from high school)
 - Apply to PC and obtain ID#
 - View online orientation
 - Complete assessment (February, March, April)
 - Meet with a counselor
 - Attend EAP event at Palomar (presentation, education plans, register for classes)

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Admissions

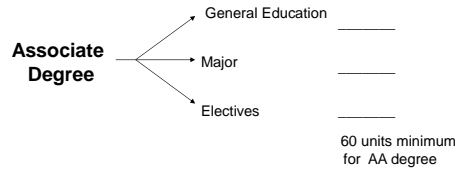
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Certificate

- Varies in units



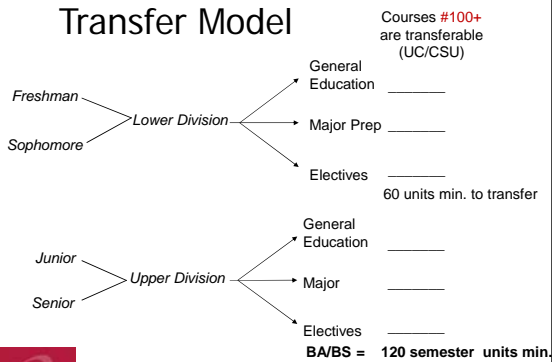
Associate Degree

Guarantee Programs

- Transfer Admission Guarantee (TAG)
 - All UCs, except Berkeley, UCLA, and UCSD
 - UC Davis: 3.2, 3.3 for Engineering
 - UCI: 3.4
 - UCM: 2.8 - 3.0
 - UCR: 3.0 - 3.2, 3.5 for Business
 - UCSB: 3.2
 - UCSC: 3.0


UCSD UniversityLink

- Family Income \$40,000 per year
- Submit application during first year
- Transfer within 3 years
- Complete all major preparation
- 3.5 GPA by end fall term before transfer
- 60 units
- 7-course pattern (both English and Math must be completed by end fall term before transfer)



Guarantee Programs

- CSUSM – Palomar & MiraCosta
 - For fall 2016, student must attend local service area college.
 - Must meet minimum criteria for admission.
 - Some majors are impacted.




Guarantee Programs


- SDSU TAG – Palomar & MiraCosta
 - For fall 2016, local service-area transfer student applicants must complete **100%** of their transferable units from Palomar or MiraCosta.
 - Only for majors **not** offered at **CSUSM**, no AD-T.
 - Does not apply to applicants to the **School of Nursing, Music and Dance, or Television, Film and New Media.**






AD-T Programs

Associate Degree for Transfer

- 60 units at community college, 60 units at university
- Transfer Model Curricula
- Additional consideration for admission into CSUs
- Different CSUs accept specific AD-T degrees
- Certain community colleges have certain AD-T degrees
- Palomar AD-T degrees:
 - Administration of Justice
 - Business Administration
 - Early Childhood Education
 - English
 - Geology
 - Journalism
 - Kinesiology
 - Math
 - Psychology
 - Sociology
 - Spanish
 - Theater

Financial Aid

Step 1: Go to www.fafsa.gov beginning Jan 1, 2016.



- Use 2015 tax information
- Select schools to send information (PC school code: 001260)

Step 2: Check Student Aid Report (SAR)

Step 3: Complete application process for school.

- Each institution will have its own protocol/process
- PC – check eServices for “To Do” list



*Entire process may take 6 – 8 weeks total

Types of Financial Aid

at the community college


- **Board of Governors Waiver**
 - Waives \$46/unit
 - Do not repay
 - Has regulations for awards
- **Pell Grant**
 - Money can be used in any manner
 - Do not repay
 - Has regulations for awards

Types of Financial Aid

at the community college

- **Loans**
 - Money can be used in any manner
 - You repay
 - Subsidized or unsubsidized
- **Scholarships**
 - Application process varies
 - Do not repay
 - Usually awarded next school year
