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# Multiple Measures Assessment

  - ❑ Scores on Other Tests (ACT, SAT, AP, CSU EAP, etc.)

  - Palomar Counselors will be available to answer your questions on your English and Math placement
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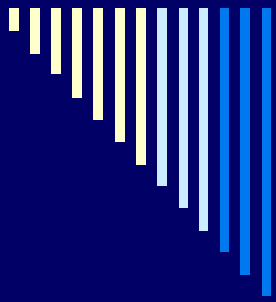

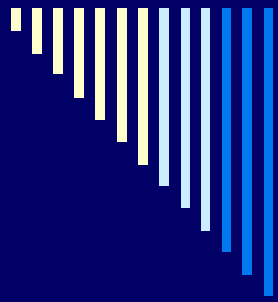
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# Palomar Promise



- ❑ All PUSD graduates are eligible
- ❑ Free Tuition, course fees
- ❑ Up to \$700 in text book assistance during the first year of enrollment
- ❑ Specialized academic and career planning with the First Year Experience (FYE) program
- ❑ Priority enrollment during first year at Palomar College
- ❑ Guaranteed Admission to CSU San Marcos if students meet transfer eligibility requirements



# Board of Governor's Fee Waiver (*BOGW*)

*BOGW* is a state sponsored program which waives enrollment fees for qualifying students.

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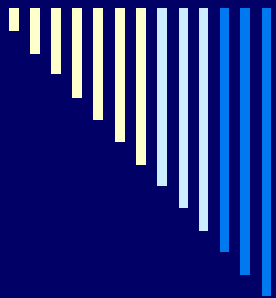


## Not 18 By the Start of Classes?
